History of the CCHCP

Since its kick-off meeting in December, 2007, the Chester County Health Care Partnership has grown to over 30 participating organizations, including hospitals, continuing care facilities, acute rehabilitation facilities, educational institutions, and county development offices.

Workforce Training

As an integral part of its mission, the CCHCP is dedicated to the recruitment and retention of health care workers. Workforce training is recognized as a fundamental component of employee retention. The CCHCP offers a number of workshops at minimal cost throughout the year in key areas vital to health care organizations as identified by the partnership.

Workforce Recruitment
